


STUDIO:

The architectural thesis is an opportunity to demonstrate the skills the students have learnt and the knowledge they have developed over the course of their studies.












BEYOND:

As we celebrate World Environment day, humanity is standing at crossroad and staring at the challenges ahead. Being at the apex of the evolution pyramid, it is the sole responsibility of Humanity not only to protect its species but also to embrace other species (Flora and Fauna) because of which ecosystem thrives. The various challenges that we are staring are as wide as it can be, from Migration to Urbanization, Development to deforestation, Population to extinction. The issues are being addressed at various levels from Global to local level. The most discussed topic in recent times at global level across various countries is "Climate change"

The construction industry is one of the significant contributors to the carbon emissions and hence to "Climate Change". On one side to meet the demand of the growing population, the supporting infrastructure development is inevitable. Architects play a vital role in striking the right balance between both keeping the ecological aspect intact. 




